July 1, 2016 Willamette Valley Community Health Plan Updates

Category: Pre-Authorization Update for Removal of Foreign Body in Ear/Nose (CPT: 69200, 69209[±], 69210 & 30300)

Effective: 07/01/2016

Change: These procedures will be covered with no pre-authorization when performed in a contracted provider's office. If appropriate, referral requirements may apply.

Category: Office Services for Contraceptive Management (DX: Z30-Z30.9) by a Non-PCP and/or Non-OB/GYN Provider

Effective: 07/01/2016

Change: No referral will be required for covered services when billed with a diagnosis within this code range, Z30-Z30.9, when administered by a contracted provider. Provider does not have to be the PCP of record or a Women's Healthcare Provider. This change is being made to support open access to women's healthcare services.

Category: Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Treatment (CPT: 0359T-0374T)

Effective: 07/01/2016

Change: The CCO will be responsible for coordinating access and administration of this benefit using current OHP guidance. Qualification and authorization criteria will apply, in accordance with the current Oregon Administrative Rule 410-172-0770: <http://www.oregon.gov/oha/healthplan/Policies/172rb04152016.pdf>

Qualification criteria: The member must be a WVCH member with a documented, supported diagnosis of an autism spectrum disorder or self-injurious behavior.

Benefit: Upon review and approval by the health plan, the member may have a benefit for intensive interventions/therapies provided by a contracted ABA therapist. Coverage is limited based on Guideline Note 75 in the Prioritized List of Health Plan Services.

Category: Changes in Coverage for Back Conditions

Effective: 07/01/2016

Change: Oregon Health Authority has made a change to cover treatment for back conditions. Prior to 07/01/2016, coverage for back conditions was limited to members with muscle weakness or other signs of nerve damage. See the Fact Sheet from Oregon Health Authority at this link for more information:

Treatments now covered by Oregon Health Authority for these conditions will be covered by WVCH, with health plan approval and within benefit limits per OHA Guidelines:

- Acupuncture*
- Chiropractic manipulation*
- Cognitive behavioral therapy (a form of talk therapy)
- Medications (PA criteria may apply)
- Office visits (Primary and Specialty Care, referral requirements may apply)
- Osteopathic manipulation*
- Physical and occupational therapy*
- Surgery (only for a limited number of conditions where evidence shows surgery is more effective than other treatment options)

*Acupuncture, Chiropractic, Osteopathic and Physical/Occupational Therapy is a combined benefit of a maximum 30 visits per benefit year for covered back conditions. Visits used for covered back conditions will count towards the total number of therapy sessions allowed as noted in Guideline Note 6.

Category: Increase in Dental Benefits for OHP Adults

Effective: 07/01/2016

Change: Added dental benefits for OHP Adults (age 21 and older)

- Crowns for molars
- Full dentures every 10 years; Partial dentures every 5 years
- Treatment for periodontia every 6 months
- Periodontal cleaning every 2 years
