Dear Member,

On June 1, 2014 your health plan, Willamette Valley Community Health (WVCH) will make a change to the list of drugs that are covered.

The list of drugs to treat Attention Deficit Hyperactive Disorder (ADHD) will be changed. The covered drugs will be:

Methylphenidate IR (Ritalin)  
Amphetamine/dextroamphetamine salts IR (Adderall)  
Methylphenidate ER (Concerta)

WVCH must approve **any** ADHD drug for people under 6 years old or over 18 years old. Your provider can contact WVCH if they want you to take one of these drugs.
